

Kindergarten ELA Virtual Lesson

DUE: Monday, January 23, 2017

Standards: K.RN.2.2 - With support, retell the main idea and key details of a text.

RI.K.10b CCSS - Use pictures and context to aid comprehension and to draw conclusions about story content

Materials: Reading Response Sheet

Students will need access to an electronic device with internet capability, pencils, crayons, and or markers.

Parent assistance is needed to read text and listen to retell.

Directions: A. With **parent** assistance, students should go to the website:

<http://more2.starfall.com/n/level-c/fiction-nonfiction/load.htm?f>

then click on the story Things That Can Go.

B. **Students** will read or listen to the story (by clicking on the ear, it will be read to them by the online narrator.)

C. After students listen to the story, **parents** will listen to the **student** retell the story. The discussion must include the main idea with 3 details from the story.

D. Then students should complete the Reading Response Sheet by doing ONE of the following:

1. **Student** draws a picture to represent the main idea and details. **Parent** writes students answers as to what the pictures represent.
2. **Student** draws a picture and writes a word that explains their picture. **Parent** writes what the student dictates.
3. **Student** writes a complete sentence for each main idea and detail.

E Reading Response Sheets are due by:

Extension: Students may read any of the other stories that are listed in the fiction / non-fiction section of the website. They can also listen to more stories by clicking on the 1) MAIN INDEX, 2) LISTENING LIBRARY.

Special Note to Parents:

When your child is attempting to write and spell words that are unfamiliar, they may:

- Find and use words from the text in the story, or
- Write the sounds they hear when saying the word out loud.

Please allow your child to answer and write independently. Responses will not be corrected or graded based on spelling accuracy.
